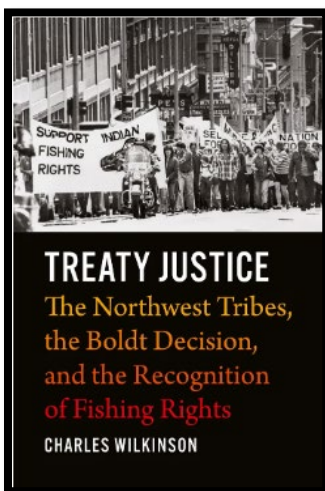
ACCESSIBILITY:
